Sunflower Model 1212 disc harrows

The Model 1212 is available in non-folding models only, and matches tractor horsepowers of 110 and lower. As with all Sunflower discs, safety lighting and SMV sign are standard equipment. The 1211 is available in 10-ft., 11-ft.-10-in., 13-ft.-3-in., and 14-ft.-7-in. cutting widths and with 22-in. or 24-in. disc blades with 8½-in. spacing. Like the larger discs in the Sunflower line, the 1212 is designed to enhance residue coverage and better penetrate a wide range of soil conditions.

The 1212 Disc Harrows are capable of performing primary and finish discing operations. Equipped with dual wheels for stability and even penetration across the width of the machine. C-Flex™ bearing standards absorb disc gang shock, and extend bearing, spool and disc blade life. Large 1¾" gang shafts with a spring washer on the ends of the gangs provide a solid foundation for maximum gang performance.
